### DAY 1 ~ IN TRANSIT

Depart your gateway city for Bangkok aboard scheduled jet service.†

### DAY 2 ~ BANGKOK

Upon arrival, transfer† to the Peninsula Hotel.

### DAY 3 ~ BANGKOK

**Educational Focus: *History and Culture of Thailand.***

**Excursion: *Bangkok.*** Cross the Chao Phraya River and discover Bangkok on a traditional *tuk-tuk*. Visit Wat Pho and see the famous Reclining Buddha. Admire the Grand Palace and the Temple of the Emerald Buddha.

**Local Flavor:** Savor a lunch of Thai specialties at a local restaurant. Gather for a *Welcome Dinner*, featuring a Thai dance performance.

### DAY 4 ~ AYUTTHAYA

**Excursion: *Ayutthaya.*** In the ancient capital of Siam, visit the Summer Palace on Bang Pa-In and the Wehat Chamrun Palace. Cruise the Chao Phraya River. Continue to a local non-profit center that is dedicated to training and caring for Asian elephants. Climb atop one for a ride!

### DAY 5 ~ BANGKOK/EASTERN & ORIENTAL EXPRESS TRAIN

**Excursion: *Jim Thompson House.*** Visit this silk pioneer's home and explore the six traditional Thai houses and teak buildings.

**Local Flavor:** Enjoy a Thai lunch. Transfer to the train station and board the Eastern & Oriental Express. As the train departs Bangkok, watch as the cityscape changes to countryside for your journey through rural Thailand and Malaysia.

### DAY 6 ~ KANCHANABURI

This morning, enjoy the scenery as the train travels through Thailand.

**Excursion: *Thailand-Burma Railway.*** From the River Kwai Bridge station, board a raft and drift down the Kwai Yai river. Learn about the Thailand-Burma railway from a local historian. Then, drive past the North Temple and Chinese Cemetery to the Thailand-Burma Railway Centre and the Don Rak War Cemetery.

### DAY 7 ~ GEORGETOWN

**Excursion: *Colonial Georgetown.***

Explore Georgetown, the capital of Penang, and its pre-World War II mosques, churches, temples, bazaars and 19th-century shophouses. Enjoy your final evening aboard the train watching the passing scenery.

### DAY 8 ~ E & OE TRAIN/ SINGAPORE

Disembark the train in Singapore.

**Excursion: *Singapore.*** Explore Merlion Park and see the iconic Merlion. Drive past the Padang, Cricket Club, Parliament House, Supreme Court and City Hall. Explore Thian Hock Keng Temple, one of the city's oldest Hokkien temples. Check in at the Mandarin Oriental.

After a morning at leisure, depart for the airport for the flight to Bali. Check in at the Ubud Hanging Gardens.

### DAY 10 ~ BALI

**Excursion: *Bali Island Tour.*** Ascend mountain slopes to visit the Mother Temple of Besakih and see Mount Batur, an active volcano. Visit Ubud, known for its art studios and boutiques.

**Local Flavor:** Lunch is served at a Balinese restaurant.

**Excursion: *Balinese Life.*** Spend the day observing daily life on the Island of the Gods. Visit a housing compound, watch as farmers work in the rice fields and chat with teachers and students at a local school. Later today, check into the Jimbaran Puri Bali Resort & Hotel.
