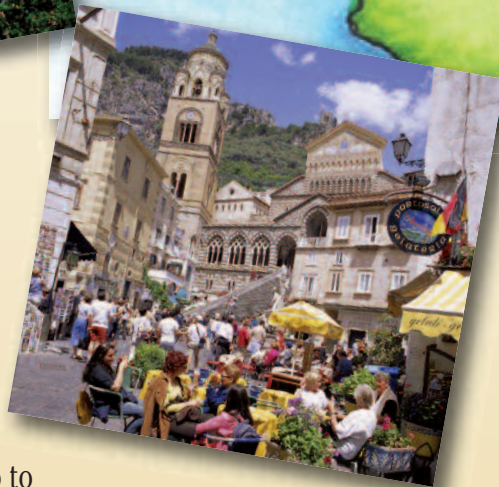

DAY 1 ~ IN TRANSIT

Depart your gateway city for Naples aboard scheduled jet service.†

DAY 2 ~ NAPLES/SORRENTO

Upon arrival, transfer† to Sorrento and the Hotel Plaza Sorrento.

Excursion: An Orientation Walk of Sorrento. Join your Campus Director on a walk through Sorrento that provides an excellent orientation of your home for the week. Experience the overall beauty of this idyllic town.

Tonight, meet your fellow travelers at a *Welcome Reception and Dinner*.

DAY 3 ~ POSITANO/AMALFI/AMALFI COAST

Educational Focus: The History and Beauty of the Province of Campania.

Excursion: Amalfi Coast. Drive along the fabled Amalfi Coast, one of the most amazing Mediterranean shores. Visit Positano, Italy's most vertical town, and the charming village of Amalfi.

Local Flavor: Lunch today is at a restaurant in Amalfi.

DAY 4 ~ PAESTUM/SALERNO

Excursion: Mozzarella. Visit a local farm where mozzarella cheese is produced from the milk of buffalo indigenous to the area. Indulge in a tasting of this famous cheese.

Excursion: Paestum. After being abandoned in the ninth century, this Greco-Roman city was overtaken by forest and forgotten until the 18th century. See a variety of ruins, including three well-preserved Doric temples.

Educational Focus and Local

Flavor: Meet the People. Chat with local residents during lunch at a restaurant in Paestum.

Return to Sorrento, and drive through the lovely town of Salerno.

Educational Focus: The Wonders of Naples' Museum.

DAY 5 ~ NAPLES

Excursion: Naples. Travel back in time with a visit to the Museo Archeologico Nazionale in Naples.

Its collection of artwork and other objects from Herculaneum and Pompeii makes it one of the most important archaeological museums in the world. Then, take a walking tour of the historic center to see the Piazza Plebiscito, Palazzo Reale and San Francesco di Paola.

Educational Focus: The Horror and Splendor of Vesuvius.

DAY 6 ~ POMPEII/HERCULANEUM

Excursion: Pompeii and Herculaneum. The sites of Herculaneum and Pompeii were destroyed when Mount Vesuvius erupted in A.D. 79. On that fateful day, the ancient seaside town of Herculaneum was preserved by mudflows, while Pompeii was covered with ash. Pompeii is known for its museum, and well-preserved frescoes and mosaics. Marvel at the treasures found at both sites.

Local Flavor: Enjoy lunch at a restaurant next to the archaeological site of Pompeii. Dinner is served at a restaurant in Sorrento.

DAY 7 ~ ISLE OF CAPRI

Excursion: Isle of Capri. Spend the day on the Isle of Dreams, home to grottoes and blissful scenes, situated majestically in a crystal-clear sea. Spend some time exploring the main town of Capri, and meander along its unique side streets.

Local Flavor: Today, indulge in more local cuisine during lunch.

DAY 8 ~ SORRENTO

Educational Focus: Contemporary Italy.

Independent Exploration: Spend the day at leisure to continue your exploration, shop or relax.

Tonight, attend a *Farewell Reception, Graduation Ceremony* and a *Farewell Dinner*.

Transfer to the airport for the return flight to your gateway city.†

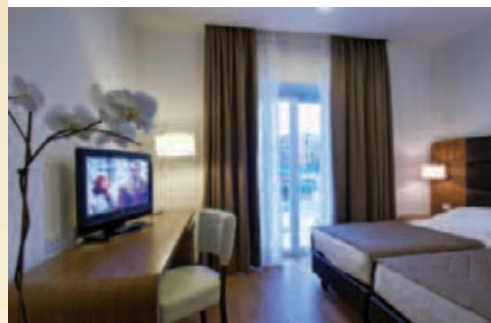
