DAY 1 ~ IN TRANSIT

Depart your gateway city for Barcelona aboard scheduled jet service.*

DAY 2 ~ BARCELONA Upon arrival, transfer* to the Cristal Palace Hotel.

Tonight, meet your fellow travelers at a *Welcome Reception* and *Dinner*.

DAY 3 ~ BARCELONA Educational Focus: The History of Catalonia and Barcelona.

Excursion: *Barcelona.* Admire Las Ramblas, a mile-long boulevard lined with cafés, flower stalls and street theater. See the Paseo de Gracia, the Champs-Élysées of Barcelona; the lush hilltop retreat of Montjuïc and the Olympic Stadium; and a panorama of Gothic and modern architecture. **Local Flavor:** Enjoy a lunch of traditional tapas.

DAY 4 ~ BARCELONA Educational Focus: *The Architecture of Gaudí*. Excursion: *Gaudí's Barcelona*.

See Gaudí's most important works, including the fascinating and unfinished La Sagrada Família, and Parc Güell's mosaic serpentine benches and commanding views. **Local Flavor:** Sample local specialties during dinner at a restaurant.

DAY 5 ~ PENEDÈS Excursion: *Penedès Winery*.

Catalonia's premier wine region produces high quality still reds and whites along with Cava, Penedès' world-famous sparkling wine. Visit a winery, known for its Cava, and explore the miles of underground wine cellars. Enjoy a tasting before returning to the city of Barcelona. **Local Flavor:** Enjoy lunch at a restaurant in the Penedès region.

Admire the breathtaking collection of modern and contemporary masterpieces, from de Kooning to Rothko. Then, see some of Bilbao's highlights, including its Old Town center. **Local Flavor:** Lunch is served at a restaurant in Bilbao.

DAY 9 ~ PAMPLONA Educational Focus: *The Romance of Hemingway and Spain.*

Excursion: *Pamplona.* Wander along the 16th-century streets of Pamplona, famous for the annual Running of the Bulls in July. Experience the famous Bullring, along with a visit to the chapel where the matadors pray before their duels and view the pens where the bulls are corralled prior to the fight. See the splendid Gothic cathedral and the chapel of San Fermín.

Local Flavor: Lunch is served at a restaurant in Pamplona. Attend a *Farewell Reception* and *Graduation Ceremony*, followed by a *Farewell Dinner*.
