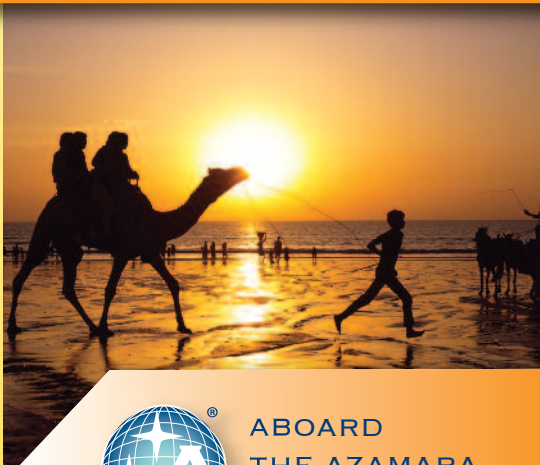

BELAWAN | SUMATRA | INDONESIA

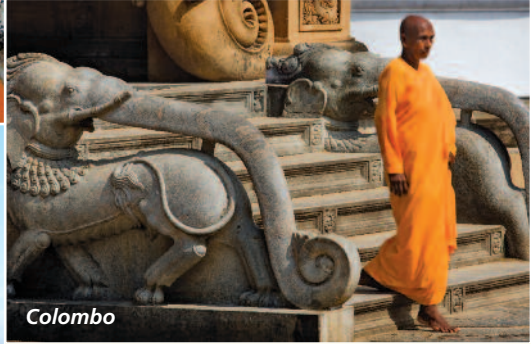
Belawan's port of Medan traces its standing as one of Indonesia's most significant harbors to the Dutch colonial era. Many visitors come to Belawan to visit an orangutan rehabilitation center, where these appealing primates are reintroduced to the wild, and to admire the scenery at Lake Toba, the immense basin born of an enormous volcanic eruption. At the center of this highland lake is the island of Samosir, which is home to the Batak people.

PHUKET | THAILAND

Floating in the sparkling waters of the Andaman Sea with palm-fringed, white-sand beaches encircling its lush green interior, the beautiful island of Phuket is nirvana for enthusiasts of water sports, golfers seeking championship courses, and nature lovers who will be thrilled by the breathtaking scenery of Phang Nga Bay. In the bay, limestone karsts thrust through the water's surface, and underwater caves are dressed to the nines in stalactites and stalagmites. Try an elephant ride through the jungle, a soothing Thai massage, or a detour through stores and galleries in handsome old Chinese shophouses.

KOCHI | INDIA

Kochi, formerly known as Cochin, exhibits its culture through a variety of sights and experiences: a tiny synagogue and a Jewish presence some claim dates back to the time of Solomon; St. Francis Church, where Vasco de Gama was once buried; Mattancherry Palace and the remarkable murals painted on its wooden walls; cantilevered Chinese fishing nets, gracefully silhouetted against sky and sea; the traditional rural lifestyle found along its extensive network of rivers, streams and canals; and the spellbinding Kathakali dance, with its highly stylized performances and elaborate makeup and costumes.

COLOMBO | SRI LANKA

The verdant isle of Sri Lanka was once known by its Arabic name of Serendib, from which the word serendipity is derived. This is a fitting description of Sri Lanka, where you will find many pleasant and serendipitous surprises as you explore this gem of an island. You will be amazed at everything it has to offer: white beaches, lush tropical forests, fragrant gardens of cinnamon and clove, and a long and equally spicy history. From Colombo, the capital, you can meet the gang at the elephant orphanage, take a trip to Kandy to visit a temple purported to house a tooth of the Buddha, or check out village life on a bicycle. Don't forget to take some of the excellent tea home with you, a product for which the island became world famous under yet another name: Ceylon.

MUMBAI | INDIA

The home of Bollywood, India's world-famous film industry, Mumbai is the glamour capital of India. Even more fascinating, however, are the aspects of daily life — from the sublime to the mundane — that constitute the real Mumbai. The majority of Indians are Hindus, believing in a vast pantheon of deities.
