SEGOVIA | LEÓN

Excursion: Segovia, Heart of Castile.

Stroll streets lined with Romanesque churches and 15th-century palaces. Visit the Plaza Mayor. See the Roman aqueduct that was built at the end of the first century and the 14th-century Alcázar.

Local Flavor: Savor regional specialties during lunch in Segovia.

Continue to León, where you will check in to the Parador de León. This parador is a former monastery that was built in the 16th century to lodge pilgrims traveling to Santiago de Compostela.

Local Flavor: Tonight, dinner is served at the parador. The restaurants in Spain's paradors

are known for their cuisine, which emphasize local ingredients and regional specialties.

DAY SIX

B

LEÓN

Excursion: León, a Medieval Treasure.

Built on the site of a Roman camp, León grew to become a major stop along the Santiago de Compostela pilgrimage route. Among its highlights are the Gothic cathedral, San Isidoro Basilica and the Royal Pantheon.

Educational Focus: El Camino de Santiago de Compostela. Since the ninth century, León has welcomed pilgrims traveling on El Camino de Santiago de Compostela, the Way of St. James of Compostela. According to tradition, James the Apostle introduced Christianity to Spain and later traveled to Judea, where he was martyred. It is said that St. James' followers brought his remains back

to Spain, where his tomb was discovered in the ninth century. Today, about 70,000 people travel El Camino each year, but during the 11th and 12th centuries, 500,000 pilgrims annually made their way to Santiago de Compostela.

DAY SEVEN

LOS PICOS DE EUROPA | SANTANDER

Excursion: *Los Picos de Europa*. This morning, depart for Santander via the Picos de Europa National Park, Spain's oldest national park and a UNESCO biosphere reserve. Sailors returning from the New World knew they were close to home once they saw the craggy limestone peaks in the distance.

Local Flavor: Enjoy lunch served at a restaurant en route to Santander.

Check in to the Hotel Real in Santander.

DAY EIGHT

SANTILLANA DEL MAR | COMILLAS

Excursion: *Towns of the Costa Verde*.

Travel the scenic coast to Santillana del Mar, one of Spain's most historic cities and one of the major stops on the Way of St. James. Enjoy free time in Santillana del Mar to explore the town or visit the Altamira National Museum, which contains exhibits about the famous

prehistoric art that decorates the walls of the cave near the city. Comillas features an interesting combination of historic and modernist architecture. One of the highlights in Comillas is El Capricho, a fanciful creation of Cataluña's most famous architect, Antoni Gaudí.

Local Flavor: Stop for lunch in Comillas.

DAY NINE

BILBAO | SAN SEBASTIÁN

Excursion: *Bilbao, a Modern Basque City*. Visit Bilbao and the Guggenheim Museum, designed by acclaimed architect Frank Gehry. Inside the museum's iconic, undulating titanium curves, you can admire an excellent collection of contemporary masterpieces by artists ranging from de Kooning to Rothko.

Local Flavor: Enjoy lunch at a restaurant in Bilbao.

Upon arrival in San Sebastián, check in to the Hotel de Londres y de Inglaterra in San Sebastián.

Educational Focus: *The History of Northern Spain*. Basque Country — País Vasco in Castilian and Euskadi in the Basque language — is one of the most intriguing regions in Spain. There is a mystique about the Basque region and its people, who are most commonly believed to be descendants of the Vascones, a tribe that lived in this region long before the Romans invaded the peninsula.

Local Flavor: Visit a restaurant in San Sebastián, a city known around the world for its delectable cuisine, for a dinner of Basque specialties.

DAY TEN

SAN SEBASTIÁN

Excursion: *A Walk Through San Sebastián*. Stroll through San Sebastián —

Donostia in the Basque language — to see the highlights of this popular resort town along the Bay of Biscay. It is considered to be one of the most beautiful cities in Spain.

Educational Focus: Contemporary History of Basque Country. Learn about recent events in Basque Country and how they have affected the development of this unique part of Spain.

DAY ELEVEN

SAINT JEAN DE LUZ, FRANCE | SAN SEBASTIÁN, SPAIN

Excursion: French Basque Country.

Discover Basque Country north of the border. Venture into France and explore a Basque town along the coast. Visit charming Saint Jean de Luz.

Independent Exploration: Enjoy time at leisure in Saint Jean de Luz for lunch. The

restaurants are known for fresh seafood and the local wine. Spend some time exploring the town before returning to San Sebastián.
