


At the time, the new genre, which combined music and theater, was so radical that the artists had no categorical name for their works other than to call them works: or, in Italian, opera. He will talk about early opera in Florence with a view toward fostering listening and appreciation skills that can be used for music of all periods. We will also commemorate the centenary of Puccini's Suor Angelica and Gianni Schicchi: operas which are set in Sienna and Florence, respectively.

Stroll through charming piazzas, including the Piazza della Repubblica, and admire the 13th-century town hall and cathedral. Step inside the Diocesan Museum to gaze at Fra Angelico's beautiful panel painting, Annunciation.

Siena

Enrichment: Renaissance Art.

Discovery: *Siena.* Perched atop three hills, this ancient city hosts an abundance of museums, architecture and cathedrals. Admire the vast, shell-shaped Piazza del Campo, the site of the bi-annual Palio horse race, and see the prominent 14th-century Torre del Mangia, the Piazza Chapel and the Civic Museum. The nearby Duomo, a true gem of Romanesque-Gothic architecture, is home to fascinating works of art and sculpture.

Free Time: Craft your own itinerary during leisure time. Savor coffee at a sidewalk café, wend Siena's cobblestones, or sample Sienese staples: panforte and ricciarelli. Revel in your day's adventures during dinner.

Day Five B | D

Florence

Discovery: Cradle of the Renaissance.

Florence is a dynamic testimony to humanity's





creative genius—one that never fails to inspire awe. Explore the city center, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and discover how the city's caché of creative genius left it laden with fine art and stunning architecture around every turn. Walk by the Old Palace, the Ponte Vecchio, the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, the Piazza della Signoria and other captivating highlights.

Free Time: Explore the wonders and gastronomic pleasures of Florence at your own pace. Perhaps visit one of Florence's worldfamous museums: the Uffizi or the Galleria dell'Accademia, home of Michelangelo's David.
